Student Exchange Program in the Faculty of Oceanology and Graduate School of Maritime Sciences

■Purpose

We plan more expansion of international student interchange, contribution of mutual education and research for each other, improvement of mutual understanding and friendship.

■ Study Period

Each semester or 1 year

First semester: from April to September Second semester: from October to March

(*Due to the spread of COVID-19, this exchange program might be postponed or canceled.)

Number of students to be admitted

We will accept the number of students specified in the Detailed Rule for the Implementation of Student Exchange between your university and Kobe University.

■ Study Field

Faculty of Oceanology and Graduate School of Maritime Sciences

*Students can take classes in other faculty/Graduate school only if they permit.

■ Eligibility

- 1. Students must be enrolled in their home university as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student, and is aiming to receive a degree from their home university after completing exchange study at Kobe University. Undergraduate students must have completed at least one year of undergraduate study at their home university at the time of coming to Kobe University.
- 2. The purpose of study abroad is clear and concrete so that the achievement of their study and research at Kobe University can be expected.
- 3. Students are required to contact a preferred major supervisor and get his/her approval before the application. Please note that we cannot accept students who focus on studying Japanese.
- 4. Students should have adequate Japanese skill in order to understand classes or conduct research in Japanese.
- 5. Students must have GPA 3.0 or above in a 4.0 scale for their completed undergraduate study at their home university.
- 6. Students should have the basic knowledge and skills required for the classes they wish to take or conduct research at Kobe University.
- 7. Students are expected to maintain good relationships with local students and faculty members of our faculty/graduate school and its neighboring community. At the same time, they are able to

contribute to the development of continued exchange between Faculty/Graduate School of Maritime Sciences, Kobe University and their home university after completing this program.

 - 1) Latest bank statement (more than 1,200,000 yen balance for 1 year stay at Kobe University as an exchange student) and a copy of the latest bank passbook
 - 2) A Certificate of employment of your financial supporter plus a certificate of his/her annual income

3. Acceptance

After we receive the application documents from your university, it will be deliberated upon. If accepted, you will be informed within 2 months.

Kobe University will apply for your COE by proxy. It will be issued within 2 months after submission. (We cannot guarantee 100% successful result of COE assessment, but most cases it has been successful.)

■ Scholarships (There is no guarantee that you can receive the scholarship!)

1. "STUDENT EXCHANGE SUPPORT PROGRAM (Scholarship for short-term study)

This scholarship is available for qualified international students accepted by Japanese universities or graduate schools under the student exchange agreement on a short-term (three months to one year)

basis.

Students will be provided the following amount in Japanese yen (*As of 2020):

1. Monthly stipend: ¥80,000 per month (up to 11 months)

This selection is done in two stages. In the first stage, Kobe University applies to JASSO based on the yearly plan of incoming students, and wait for a notice of scholarship quota. The second stage involves reviewing and selection of students by Kobe University from the submitted applications.

Students who wish to apply for this scholarship must submit the application form when applying for international student exchange program. (Prescribed Form)

2. HUMAP

HUMAP (Hyogo University Mobility in Asia and the Pacific) is an international intercollegiate exchange program between universities in the Hyogo region of Japan and the rest of the Asia Pacific region.

Eligibility: Students from HUMAP member universities

Duration: 6 months to 1 year

Students will be provided the following amount in Japanese yen (*As of 2020) :

1. Monthly stipend: ¥80,000 per month (up to 12 months)

Selection process is the same as JASSO scholarship above.

Students who wish to apply for this scholarship must submit the application form when applying for international student exchange program. 《Prescribed Form》
